

1. Upon opening the app, users are prompted to enter their username.




2. Subsequently, they are required to input a 9-digit OTP (One-Time Password) for authentication.

4. They are then presented with the user interface where they can access the app's features and functionalities for secure audio-video conferencing.




Interface Overview

Upon logging into qVAC, users are presented with a straightforward and intuitive interface designed to streamline their audio-video conferencing experience. The interface consists of four primary tabs, each serving a distinct purpose:

1. **All Tab:**

- In the "All" tab, users can view a comprehensive list of all meetings associated with their account. This includes meetings that are currently ongoing, scheduled for the future, or have already concluded.
- Users have the ability to quickly access details of past meetings, review meeting notes, or access recordings directly from this tab.



2. Ongoing Tab:

- The "Ongoing" tab provides users with real-time visibility into meetings that are currently in progress. Here, users can easily join ongoing meetings with just a single tap, facilitating seamless participation.
- Users can also view pertinent meeting information such as participants, agenda items, and active discussions within this tab.


3. **Upcoming Tab:**

- Users can access detailed meeting logs, including attendance records, chat transcripts, and recorded sessions, for reference or archival purposes.




Joining a Conference

In qVAC for iOS, when a user receives an invitation to join a conference, the invitation is displayed in both the "All Meetings" and "Upcoming Meetings" sections. Upon receiving the invitation, the user is presented with a single option: the "Join" button.

1. Joining the Conference:

- To accept the invitation and join the conference, the user simply taps on the "Join" button.
- Tapping the "Join" button seamlessly adds the user to the conference, launching the meeting interface for immediate participation.



Hosting a Conference

To initiate a conference in qVAC, users have two options accessible via the plus icon located at the bottom right corner the app:

Select an option Schedule a meeting Quickstart a meeting Cancel


1. QuickStart a Meeting:

- Upon selecting "QuickStart a Meeting" users are prompted to provide essential details for the conference, including the meeting name, description, and invitees.
- After inputting the necessary information, users can initiate the meeting by clicking the "QuickStart Meeting" button.
- The instant meeting commences immediately, enabling participants to join the discussion promptly.
- Subsequently, the newly created meeting is automatically added to the "Ongoing" tab for easy access and participation.

2. Schedule a Meeting:

- Opting for "Schedule a Meeting" prompts users to input specific details to plan a future conference.
- Users are required to specify the meeting name, description, start date, start time, end date, end time, and select invitees.
- Once all details are entered, users can confirm the scheduling by clicking the "Create" button.
- The scheduled meeting is then added to the "Scheduled" tab, where users can review upcoming conferences and prepare accordingly.



Conference Controls

Once users have joined a meeting in qVAC, they have access to a set of essential controls conveniently located at the bottom of the interface. These controls facilitate seamless management of audio, video, screen sharing, and other conference-related functionalities.

1. Video Toggle:

• The first button allows users to toggle their video feed on or off, enabling them to control their visibility during the conference.

2. Camera Switch:

• The scond button enables users to switch between front and back camera views on their device, offering flexibility in choosing the desired camera perspective.

3. End Call:

• The third button allows users to gracefully exit the conference, terminating their participation in the ongoing meeting.

4. Microphone Toggle:

• The fourth button enables users to mute or unmute their microphone, regulating their audio input during the conference.

5. Audio Output Mode:

• The fifth button provides users with the option to change the audio output mode, allowing them to select the desired audio output device for the conference.

6. Screen Sharing:

• The sixth button initiates screen sharing functionality, enabling users to broadcast their screen contents to other participants in the conference.







Customization Options & Account Settings

Within the "Settings" menu in qVAC, users have access to various customization options and account settings to personalize their experience. The settings are divided into three sections: User Settings, Notifications, and About.

1. Sign Out:

• The "Sign Out" option allows users to securely log out of their qVAC account, ensuring privacy and account security.

2. User Settings:

- **Profile Picture:** Users can upload or change their profile picture, allowing them to personalize their account representation within the app.
